**REPORTS**

**REGISTRAR:** John thanked Roland for working with Diego. The new program is getting better. Thank you to all of the league registrars for the work they do. He personally does not like pictures of the players on the program.

**TREASURER:** The books were closed on August 31. Staff is to turn in any requests for reimbursement. John stated that he voted No on the Executive Director and the car.

**CUPS:** Cup rules were approved. John does not support U-9 cup play.

**COACHING:** John said that we have had many courses this year. We still have two coming up. USSF E course attendees will not have their license posted until Karl signs off because it is a pass/fail course.

**TOP SOCCER:** Still trying to work out jamborees.

**RECREATION:** Karl submitted a written report. Congratulations to the following MichaelRay Ceja-Selma, Ricardo Zamora-Selma, David Pierce-Valley and Craig Kent on becoming Official Staff Instructors. He also thanked several people for helping with Pre F clinics and sending articles for Karl's Comments.

**D7PP:** Diego submitted a written report. The Fall season is starting and we have had only about 5 issues out of 105 games. We lost Storey but moved the games to Sequoia Middle School. He asks that coaches **PLEASE CHECK THE SCHEDULE AND THEIR GAME CARDS** to avoid problems. There were teams with no pictures on passes, were not laminated and one team with more players than allowed, hand written players on the game card. This will not be tolerated, everyone must obey the rules.

**REFEREES:** The number one goal is to get the refs to be dressed properly. Some problems came up where one ref did half a game and another did the last half. This cannot happen. It is the assignor's responsibility to assign well dressed refs. Unlicensed referees will not be paid. John is posting pictures of poorly dressed refs on the "Wall of Shame" in the office.

**COMMISSIONER'S REPORT:** Cup rules and the budget have been passed by the CYSA BOD. They strongly recommend that U-14 and below are not to be taught heading because of Class Action suits on concussions. He has received complaints from parents and coaches that we do not have enough teams for U-9s. Only two applied.
