

District 7 Facilitator Course

Purpose: Provide a quick and financially affordable way for interested individuals to

receive some basic training and instruction and be available to help with

local, in-house ONLY, soccer games.

Course: Length one day—5 hours. Minimum age is 13 years old.

18 and older must complete a background check.

Time and location to be determined by the hosting league and coordinated

with the instructor.

Cost: Hosting league pays \$0.60 per mile and a flat course fee of \$30.

The \$30 fee to be paid to the instructor on the day of the course. The league or hosting party will be sent a bill for the mileage

Responsibilities of hosting league: provide a room with power for computer and projector (also a screen). Prepare information regarding the protocol for the payment (how much and when) of these facilitators.

Field locations, season of games and contact information.

Responsibilities of participants: be on time with material to take notes (paper and pen). Bring drinks, snacks, and if available, flags, coin, watch and whistle.

Uniform: Shirts—grey and/or black Shorts---all black with pockets and no stripes

Socks—solid black Shoes—mostly black

End of course: participants receive: whistle, red and yellow card, a signed ID card (proof of completion of the course), iron on badge.

Responsibilities of league assignors: Only assign these facilitators to in-house games up to and including U-16. Provide many opportunities to work games. Find experienced individuals who can help with coaching and mentoring during matches.

Schedule a YEARLY refresher meeting prior to the start of each season.

At any time, those ready to work competitive games should sign up for the USSF licensing course.
